Steps in Course

Topic	<u>Students will:</u>

Proposal

Students will:

1. After topic is approved, prepare the proposal. See the Proposal section of the course Web site.
2. Submit proposal within the 1st 5 weeks of the course to the Distance Education Coordinator

Instructors will:

1. Review completed project proposals and provide feedback in approximately two weeks after the proposal due date

Progress**Students will:**

1. Provide instructors with a brief summary (half-page) regarding project development and results via-email to the Distance Ed. Coordinator
2. Depending on time-frame for individual projects, provide a minimum of 2 progress reports

Instructors will:

1. Provide feedback on progress to students within one week

Portfolio

Students will:

1. Provide the completed MS project portfolio to instructors. Hard copies and electronic copies of materials must be provided according to project requirements outlined in Project Requirements and Guidelines section of the course Web site.
2. Submit the portfolio within 4 semesters of registering for Entomology 888. Portfolios must be submitted no later than 5 weeks before the end of the semester to be considered for a grade in that semester. See the Project Submission section of the course Web site.

Instructors will:

1. Provide a written review of materials and formal approval of portfolio via email
2. Reviews will usually be provided within 2 weeks, however, up to one month may be required for review
