

### ***Insect Field Ecology Lab Assistant***

The insect field ecology lab is seeking a highly motivated individual to assist with lab and field research on UNL East Campus and Eastern Nebraska Research, Extension and Education Center (ENREEC), and at on-farm sites in the east-central NE. Lab duties include colony work, data collection and entry, greenhouse work, and general cleaning and organizing. Fieldwork includes plot evaluations, plot maintenance, and data collection in both soybean and corn under the direction of a supervisor. Individuals in the lab will gain experience with a new pest in soybean, the soybean gall midge, popcorn trials, and get hands-on experience with a simulated hail machine! Fieldwork requires traveling throughout eastern Nebraska to multiple sites throughout the season. No prior knowledge is necessary. Pay is competitive and will depend on prior experience and education level. Applicants must have a valid driver's license. This position is located on UNL East Campus.
